Smith closed the gap near the end of the race but Buchan took the chequered flag by four tenths of a second. Meanwhile David Eason had settled into third and took the position. Cliff Harper headed a group of five drivers of Grant Cheesewright, Richard Johnstone, Ian Duncan and Michael Christie and this was the order they finished.

Dennis Rose presented the Dickie Bent Cup to James Wood who had been selected by the marshals as the most impressive novice on the day.
