GKC open race meeting with COVD-19 restrictions

## Race format one day race meetings.

Saturday race meeting for Bambinos, Cadets, Mini Max and Jnr Max Sunday race meeting for Jnr Prokarts (owner drivers), Snr Prokarts (owner drivers), Snr Max, Clubman Max, 177 Max, KZ2

- Cost £40 for club members, £50 for non-club members and transponder hire £10 payment at the track bring the correct money.
- Signing on online and class sized limited to 24 drivers.
- Practice 9.00 am to 12.00pm each class will have 8-minute timed sessions.
- Drivers briefing 12.30 Location dummy grid with current Scottish Government social distance requirement.
- Bambinos 4 timed heats duration 8 minutes, fastest time 0 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest 2 points 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest 3 points and so on. Results from each heat counted and lowest overall score is 1<sup>st</sup> next 2<sup>nd</sup> and so on.
- All other class
  - 1<sup>st</sup> heat 8-minute time session Drivers will form up on the dummy grid the Grid Marshal will indicate when you can join the track for your session. If you come in before the timed session finishes you are not allowed to make adjustments to the kart or go back out on track. Points will be awarded fastest time 0 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest 2 points 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest 3 points and so on and these will count towards your grid position for the final.
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Grid positions for heat 2 is allocated by order of entry and then reversed for heat 3  $\,$
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> heats 8-minutes plus a lap points awarded 1<sup>st</sup> 0 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 2 points 3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points and so on. Results from each heat counted and lowest overall score is pole next 2<sup>nd</sup> and so on.
  - Final 9-minutes plus a lap.
- Heats commence at 12.40pm followed by the finals


## **Social Distancing Restrictions**

- In line with the current Scottish Government COVID-19 guidelines GKC are restricting the number of people on site.
- Bambino, Cadets and Jnr Drivers are allowed 2 adults from your household, it is the parent/guardian responsibility to ensure you and your driver maintain the current social distance of 2m from people out with your household.
- To assist in returning your driver to the track each Bambino, Cadets and Jnr Driver will have a pusher who will go out on track during their practice sessions, heats and final. Pushers out on track will wear their face covering.
- Snr classes the driver is allowed 1 adult from your household, it is both the driver and helpers responsibility to ensure you both maintain the current social distance of 2m from people out with your household.
- Please bring with you a face covering and hand sanitiser, we ask you use these in the dummy grid and parc ferme area's and around any of the GKC Officials/Marshal Team
- To assist in maintaining social distancing the Driver will arrive at the dummy grid with their helmet and gloves on, these are to remain on when the driver goes through parc ferme and


scrutineering and removed once they are back in their paddock space, except for medical intervention.

• No overnight camping you are to arrive at the club on the date of your practice and race, leaving once your race meeting is concluded.

GKC committee members have the right to send home anyone breaching guidance as this could shut the club down.



Drivers will enter the dummy grid holding area via the gate next to race control and make their way over to the fence before being directed into the dummy grid. Odd numbers on grid A and even numbers on grid B



Drivers leaving the track who are not directed through scrutineering will leave via the gate in front of the clubhouse making their way back to their paddock space.

Penalties will be issued in line with BDOC regs at a suitable area outside which will be designated to convey this information to the driver/parent guardian should this necessary. If a driver needs to report a racing incident the driving standard steward (Clerk of Course) can be called up via either Parc ferme marshal or Grid marshal assistant. Social distance is to be maintained and a face covering maybe required.

## Parking in the paddock

In line with the current Scottish Government COVID -19 guidelines please leave 2-meter distance between each paddock space, no team tents, no sharing of tools between different households. Open side gazebos/pull out awnings are allowed. The GKC paddock marshal will advise on suitable place to park.
